











Shanghai Intelligent Building Technology (SIBT) will be held in halls W3, W4 and W5 at the Shanghai New International Expo Centre (SNIEC) from 31 August to 2 September 2022.

Market news

1. China's intelligent building market exceeded RMB 965 billion in 2019 and is expected to exceed 1.2 trillion by 2023. In the future, the proportion of intelligent buildings in new builds will continue to rise. With the trend of transforming existing buildings with the use of smart building technologies, the domestic intelligent building market will keep growing and is estimated to reach 1.54 trillion by 2026.

2. In 2025, there will be over 4.08 million office workers working in smart office environments across China; 90% of gated communities in the country will use smart licence plate recognition for parking; a total of 12.75 million residential units will make use of pre-installed smart home technologies, benefitting over 44.6 million residents. Furthermore, approximately 700 hotels will be upgraded to 'Al hotels'.




